
The Challenge

The current school system creates inequality, stifles creativity, and fuels a mental health crisis.

- 1. Unequal access to resources
- 2. Teacher shortage and burnout
- 3. Standardization and obsession with testing
- 4. Mental health crisis among young people
- Too often, school stifles children's potential instead of awakening it.

⚠ The Quebec government has imposed \$570 million in education cuts for 2025–2026, confirming the urgent need for massive reinvestment in education.







A pivotal moment in Quebec

Across Quebec, families are calling for change — seeking an education that is more humane, inclusive, and joyful.

- Education that nurtures **curiosity** and **intrinsic motivation**.
- More humane, inclusive, and flexible environments.
- Community-based educational alternatives.
- Funding education as a national priority.
- **✓ Sound of Joy!** is a continuation of the Lab-École school innovation incubator and the citizen white paper Debout pour l'école moving from architectural innovation to educational and human transformation. Quebec is calling for a citizen-led, sustainable overhaul of its education system.







The Sound of Joy! Solution

A vibrant and relational school, guided by the heart, mind, and joy of learning, open to the world and citizenship.

- A Way of Being the quality of relationships between adults and children is the foundation of all learning.
- Authentic & Connected Relationships cultivating trust, kindness, and presence rather than performance.
- Child-Centered meeting each student where they are, from their perspective and at their pace.
- Learning with Heart & Mind well-being, curiosity, and intrinsic motivation guide the way.
- Experiential & Creative Projects maker spaces, arts, sciences, music, and living nature encourage hands-on discovery.
- Exploration of Nature & Living Things hiking, gardening, sensory experiences, and scientific observation.
- Restorative Practices learning through cooperation, conflict resolution, and emotional growth.
- Alternative Assessment progress monitored using qualitative tools (including the Rickter scale) to express feelings and progress beyond grades.
- Civic & Global Awareness awakening ethical, intercultural, and ecological consciousness of the world.

✓ More than just a different kind of school – a relational, living, and forward-looking model that cultivates joy, autonomy, and citizenship.







Compliance & Regulatory Framework

A pilot project that complies with the Quebec Ministry of Education (MEQ) school standards, while paving the way for a new educational model.

- Qualified & Accredited teachers, trained in relational and experiential approaches.
- MEQ Program Fully Respected, with all core subjects integrated into lively and concrete projects.
- Benevolent & Balanced Assessments, combining official MEQ tools and qualitative approaches (such as the Rickter scale).
- Personalized Support to help each student learn at their own pace and according to their needs.
- Clear Transitions to Secondary School, ensuring recognition and continuity of the educational path.
- A credible and compliant school that combines rigor and innovation.







Two-phase pilot project

A gradual, measured, and realistic rollout—to ensure the quality, stability, and development of every child.


Phase 1 – Validation (2 years)

- Hosting a small group of 40 to 60 students in a warm, intimate environment.
- Dedicated team of educators and specialists trained in the relational approach.
- Impact assessment: well-being, commitment, motivation, and perseverance.

Phase 2 - Consolidation (3 years)

- Gradual expansion to 80 to 120 students.
- Development of a comprehensive model that can be replicated and transferred to other communities in Quebec.
- ← Gentle, controlled growth to build on solid, human foundations.
